Through our **Undergraduate Transfer Scholarship Program**, we provide scholarships worth up to **\$30,000** per year to community college students to help them earn a four-year degree.

To be eligible for the **Undergraduate Transfer Scholarship Program**, a candidate must:

- Be a current student at an accredited US community college or two-year institution with sophomore status, OR a recent graduate (within the last five years),
- Have a cumulative college grade point average of 3.50 or better on a 4.0 scale (or the equivalent),
- Plan to transfer to a four-year college or university to begin studies in the coming fall,
- Be nominated by his or her two-year institution, and
- Have significant unmet financial need.
